- **Songs:** To provide an entertaining and memorable context for particularly challenging grammar topics, approximately 500 songs have been incorporated in the book. Musical note images () indicate sentences from these songs. The titles and official links to the songs are given at the end of each part in a unit through superscript numbers 1, 2, 3, 4, etc. At the end of each unit, QR codes for all the songs with official links used in that particular unit are provided in alphabetical order.
- Appendices: Six useful appendices precede the index, covering Active Verb Tense Forms, Adding -s, -ing & -ed to Verbs, Irregular Verbs, Phrasal Verbs, "Word + Preposition" Combinations and Prepositional Phrases & Idiomatic Expressions.
- Index: The book includes a subject-based index in alphabetical order. When searching for a specific grammar topic, it is highly recommended to use the index rather than the contents page for efficient navigation.
