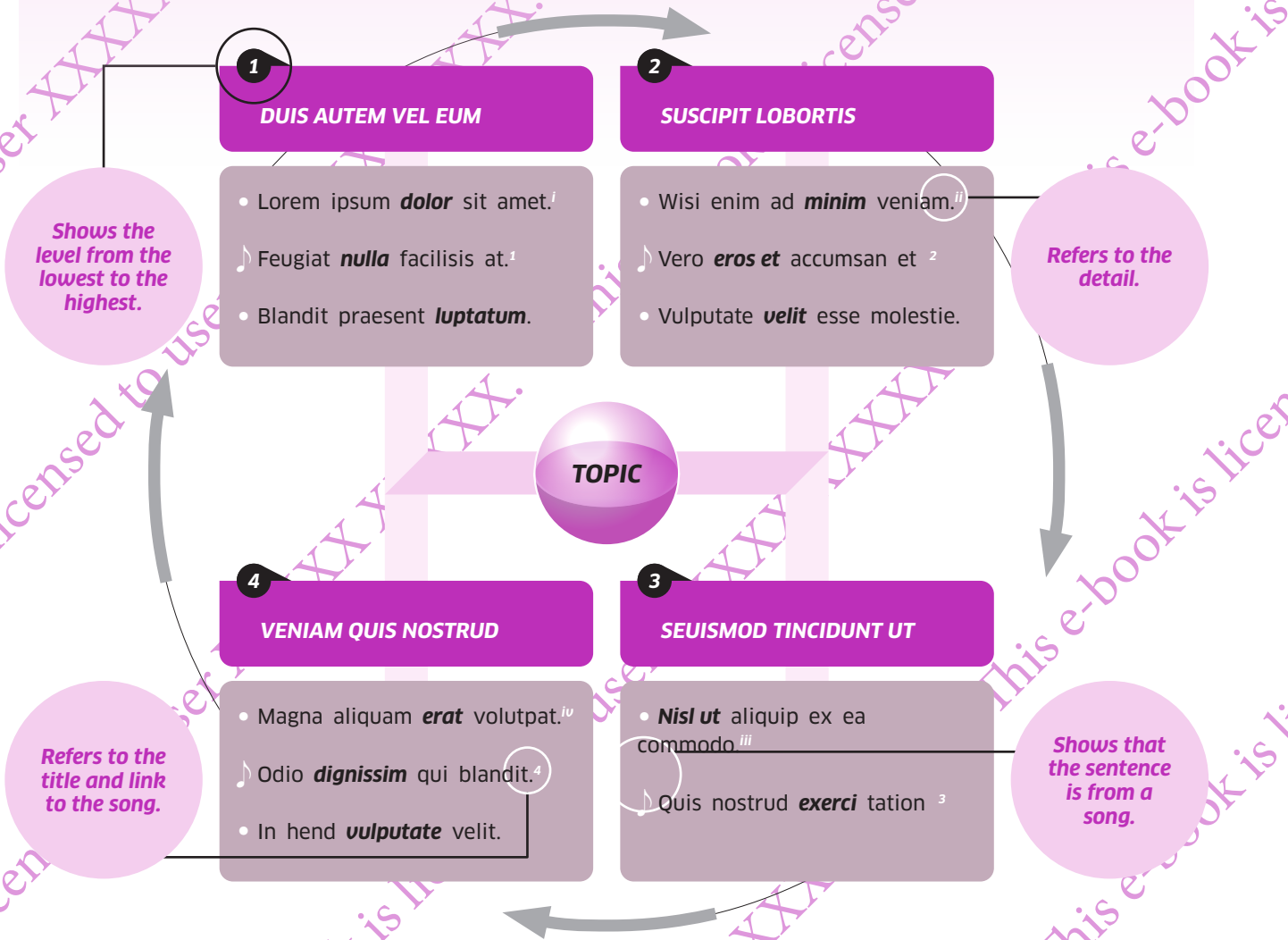

## INTRODUCTION

Designed to address the most common challenges in English grammar with approximately 500 songs, *Shortcut to English Grammar and Practice* is an all-level (from A to C) grammar book that presents grammar topics from the lowest to the highest level through clockwise-flowing infographics. The book comprises eight key elements

- 1 **Overview:** Each unit begins with an Overview section, providing a bird s-eye view of the grammar topic and its gradual elaboration from the lowest to the highest level. This section allows readers to gain a quick understanding of the subject s general scope.
- 2 **Infographics:** Grammar topics are visually presented with main categories and examples, progressing from the lowest to the highest level using clockwise-flowing infographics. Numbers (1, 2, 3, 4) denote the level, while superscript Roman numerals (i, ii, iii, iv, v, etc.) indicate the detailed notes found in the Details section. Musical notes (♪) signify sentences from songs.



- 3 ➤ **Warnings:** English grammar includes exceptions and pitfalls, challenging particularly for EFL students. These are presented in warning boxes to aid learners in identifying and addressing the potential stumbling blocks.
- 4 ➤ **Common Mistakes:** Following the presentation of each grammar topic, a Common Mistakes section showcases the errors most frequently made by EFL students, along with their corrected versions.
- 5 ➤ **Details:** Grammar topics depicted with their main aspects in the infographics are elaborated in the Details section using superscript Roman numerals (i, ii, iii, iv, etc.).
- 6 ➤ **Songs:** To provide an entertaining and memorable context for particularly challenging grammar topics, approximately 500 songs have been incorporated in the book. Musical note images (♪) indicate sentences from these songs. The titles and official links to the songs are given at the end of each part in a unit through superscript numbers <sup>1</sup>, <sup>2</sup>, <sup>3</sup>, <sup>4</sup>, etc. At the end of each unit, QR codes for all the songs with official links used in that particular unit are provided in alphabetical order.
- 7 ➤ **Appendices:** Six useful appendices precede the index, covering **Active Verb Tense Forms, Adding -s, -ing & -ed to Verbs, Irregular Verbs, Phrasal Verbs, “Word + Preposition” Combinations** and **Prepositional Phrases & Idiomatic Expressions**.
- 8 ➤ **Index:** The book includes a subject-based index in alphabetical order. When searching for a specific grammar topic, it is highly recommended to use the index rather than the contents page for efficient navigation.
